Projects on the West Coast range from the historic restoration of Santa Barbara's 1930s era Francheschi House to a new light filled 12,000 square foot Italian Renaissance Revival estate located just north of Los Angeles overlooking the mountains of Malibu and the grounds of the Santa Monica Nature Conservancy.

Harrison Design Associates is also opening an office in Beverly Hills in Spring 2007.





Notable Historic Restoration And Selected Projects

- Historic Restoration of the Santa Barbara City's 1930s era Francheschi House to be used as a Museum, Education & Meeting Facility and Resource Center.
- Master Plan Update including the construction of a gymnasium, classrooms and administration center for a private school located in southern Santa Barbara County with an emphasis on the existing rural vernacular, yet incorporating green building technologies, site planning and construction methods.

Notable Custom Residential Projects

- Light filled 12,000 square foot Italian Renaissance Revival Estate located just north of Los Angeles. The dining room is designed for up to twenty four guests with a large display for the family's collection of fine wines at one end and a spectacular two story carved stone fireplace at the other. The home is complete with media room, two story library, music room, and expansive outdoor living areas.
- Sir Edwin Lutyens inspired 15,000 square foot English Manor estate set in the shadow of Brokentop Mountain with views of Mt. Bachelor and the Three Sisters in southeast Oregon, designed with two main objectives: maximize the expansive views and embody the character and quality of the natural surroundings. The proportions and detailing of the materials throughout the project create a harmonious connection between the architecture and the beauty of the site. Meandering stacked stone landscape walls complement the home as it rises from the site. The home includes wood paneled rooms; domed, barrel vaulted wood beam and coffered ceilings; hand carved stone fireplaces; and dramatic two story living spaces.
- Spanish Mediterranean style estate set in the foothills of Montecito overlooking the Pacific to the south and the Los Padres National Forest to the north, and includes a small vineyard and citrus grove. The design uses onsite natural, hand made and recycled materials for construction including sandstone, reclaimed timbers, beams and flooring, hand troweled plaster; fresco painting; adobe clay; plus hand glazed tiles, hand wrought iron; and hand made fixtures.
